ECHO CANYON WALK

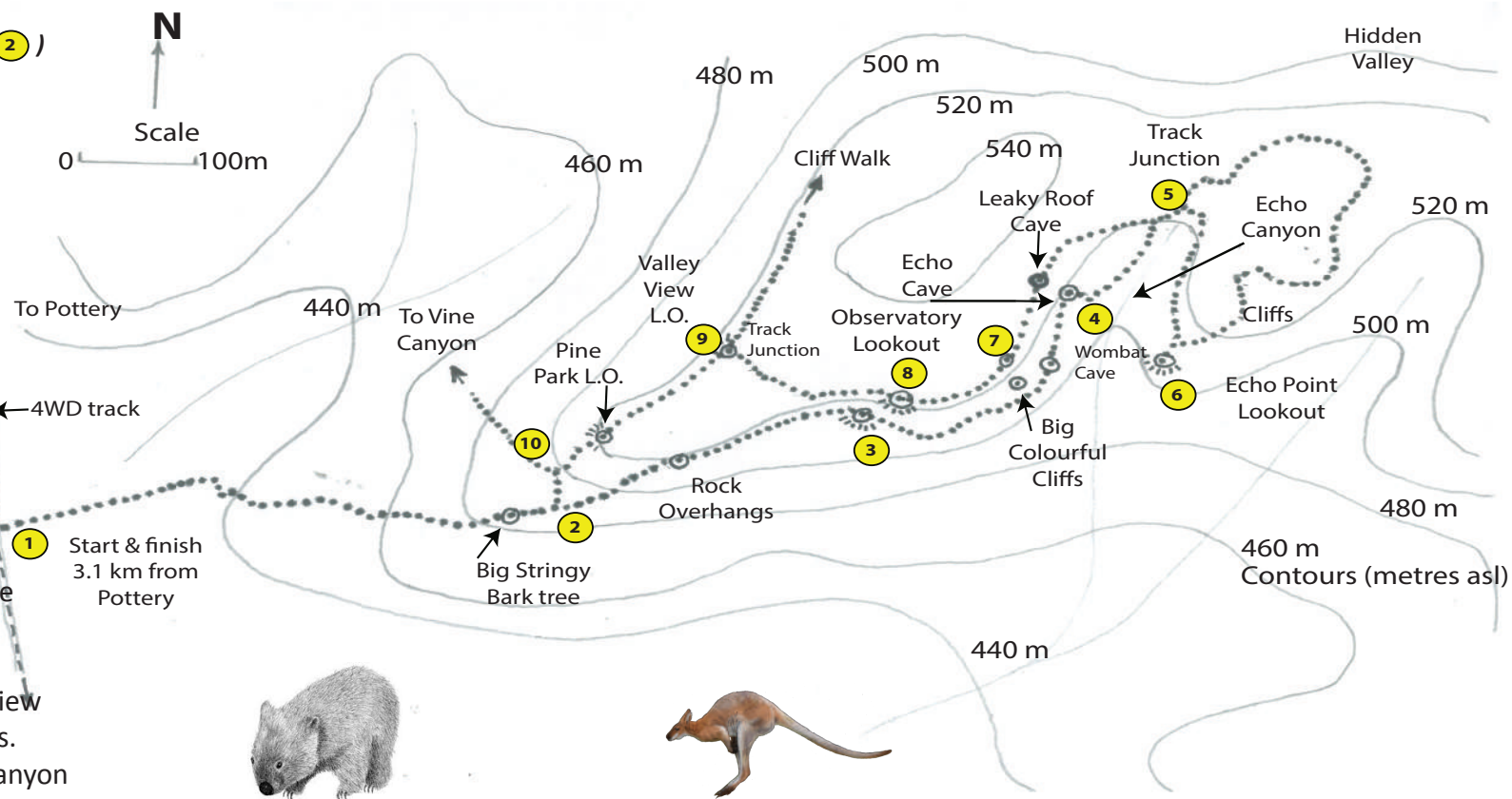
MAP USERS PLEASE NOTE:

To simplify map details, all distances and locations are approximate only.

ECHO CANYON WALK

CHECK POINTS (Notes read anti-clockwise from 2)

- 1 Start & finish on the track to Pine Park. Head in an Easterly direction.
- 2 Track Junction, go straight ahead (track to left links to cliff walk)
- 3 Big Cliff, with good views, continue ahead.
- 4 Echo Cave, continue up the canyon.
- 5 Track Junction, turn left to complete the first loop or go straight ahead for the 2nd loop.
- 6 Echo Point Lookout, back track a short distance and turn right.
- 5 Track Junction, turn right to rejoin first loop.
- 7 Top of Cliff opposite Echo Point L.O. continue along cliff top.
- 8 Observatory Lookout.
- 9 Track Junction with Cliff Walk, (also Valley View lookout), turn left and follow Cliff Walk Signs.
- 10 Track junction, turn left to complete Echo Canyon Walk.
- 2 Track Junction, turn right and go back to start.
- 1 Start & Finish.



ECHO CANYON WALK.

CAUTION: This walk has steep sections with loose rocks and unfenced cliff edges.

NOT SUITABLE FOR SMALL CHILDREN OR UNFIT PERSONS.

A 3.3 km double loop walk with 5 lookouts and many caves. Allow 1.5 to 2.0 hours. Elevation change of about 110 m (Start 420m asl to 530m asl) Grades are gradual with some steep sections between 2 & 4, 9 & 10.
